SCARC FOUNDATION'S TWILIGHT BALL NETS \$100,000

The Ball was held at Perona Farms on Saturday May 14th and the theme was "Japan".

"It is our vision to continue to ensure that SCARC will be a viable organization for many years to come," said Dominick V. Romano. "Ronetco Supermarkets is honored to raise funds for individuals with developmental disabilities in Sussex County and we are proud to be a part of this wonderful fundraiser for the past 27 years," he added.

There are three separate non-profit corporations under the "SCARC" umbrella, each having its own individual governing board. The SCARC Foundation, Inc. raises funds to provide programs to individuals who are receiving services through SCARC, Inc. and SCARC Guardianship Services, Inc.

Through the support of the Sussex County community and corporate donors, the SCARC Foundation has been able to fund over \$250,000 this year for needed services such as, respite and family support services for 150 families, recreational activities for 350 children and adults, summer day camp for 27 children and guardianship services for 40 adults with developmental disabilities.
